TORONTO CAMP (SH28)	Sept 27th 12h	12h	Battalion proceed by march route from AUDENFORT to BANNINGBURG (HALEBROUCE) + entrained for RENNINGHEST (SH28) departing at 8pm and thence by march route to TORONTO CAMP (SH28 G18a) arriving at 9pm.	H
SH28	28th	6am	<u>Commencement of active operations.</u> The Battalion proceed by march route to Brigade assembly area at SWAN CHATEAU (SH28 I-19c) to await orders. There were received at 10.15am + the march commenced to the position of line behind MTSORREL (SH28 I 30a) where the battalion formed up at 1pm on a bearing of 58° T. At 3pm orders were received for the advance to commence on a bearing of 146° T. The final objective being a distance of 4000 yds with the Right of the Brigade on KORTENWIDE (SH28 J13b). The 26th Battalion ROYAL FUSILIERS being on the left of the Brigade + covering 750 yds having the 10th BATTAL QUEZONS R.M.S. Bpt. on its right. The Battalion advanced steadily having 2 Coys in front + 2 in support, each Coy having 2 platoons + 1 platoon each with 2 section leaders + covered by 2 platoons. Considerable opposition was met with from enemy M.C. posts + snipers but these were gradually outflanked + surrounded. The advance proceeded in bounds of 300 yards and	H
